





## *Voices that Inspire!* *On English Language Day*






## Educational Visit to Jaipur Rugs – Grade XI Commerce & Humanities


### *Importance of Teamwork*

## Space Mysteries Scientists Still Can't Solve

Space is full of wonders, but it is also full of questions that even the world's smartest scientists cannot answer. Every rocket launched, every telescope sent into orbit, and every picture taken of distant galaxies brings us a little closer to the truth... yet many mysteries remain unsolved. Here are some of the most fascinating ones.



### 1. What is dark matter made of?

Scientists believe that the stars, planets, and galaxies we see make up only 5% of the universe. The rest is something invisible called dark matter and dark energy. We can't see it, touch it, or detect it directly — but it holds the universe together like a cosmic glue.

### 2. How do black holes really work?

### 4. What happened before the big bang?




But here's the real question: Are we using AI, or is AI starting to use us?
